#### **Record player/Bluetooth Speaker**

To play a record: Push the Standby/On button to turn on, then push Phono, then Play once you have a record on the player.

To play music via Bluetooth: Push the Standby/On button, then push BT, use your phone to connect to Geekoala LP-56U-BT

#### **Heating and Cooling**

Adjustments can be made using the dial on the Nest thermostat in the dining room. We try to keep the temperature at 70 degrees, please save energy by keeping windows and doors closed while heating and A/C is on.

#### **Parking**

There is room for two cars to park tandem in our driveway to the left of the home. Please park in front of the wood gate, as we like to keep the wood gate closed and it's difficult to back out of the gate. There is also open street parking available for additional vehicles.

#### **Air Mattress**

There is an air mattress located in the closet at the front entry. Just plug it in to inflate. Pillows and linens for the sleeper are in the cedar chest in the front entry.

#### **Rear Door**

Can be propped open by opening the door and pressing the button on the shock to hold the door in position. To close, open the door all the way to release button, then allow door to close.

- Throw away garbage and recycling in respective bins in the backyard. Lock door behind you by pressing "Schlage" on the keypad.

Cleveland is a Foodie City with so many amazing spots to try, you can't go wrong. Below is a collection of our favorite local spots worth a visit (and delivery). Most are within walking distance to the house which makes it easy to have an extra drink (or two).

### Happy Hour / / Ninja City Kitchen & Bar - 6706 Detroit Ave

An eclectic menu and drink selection, everything is delicious! Our favorites are the dumplings, pork buns, papaya salad, and smash burgers.

#### Brewery / / Saucy Brew Works - 2885 Detroit Ave

Lofty warehouse space with amazing craft brews. ASAP IPA and an assortment of other delicious brews on tap. Wood fired pizza, wings and fresh salads are also amazing.

#### Pinball Bar / / Superelectric Pinball Parlor - 6500 Detroit Ave

Pinball and craft brews, this place is perfect for a fun night out.

#### Dive Bar / / Happy Dog - 5801 Detroit Ave

The Happy Dog is a neighborhood corner bar in the best sense of the term. Sometimes you just want to eat hot dogs with cereal on them while listening to local rock n' roll. For those times, there's the Happy Dog.

### Coffee / / RIsing Star Coffee Roasters - 1455 W 29th St

Great coffee in a historic firehouse, a nice place to hang out, work on your laptop, and listen to music as you drink your coffee.

#### Donuts / / Brewnuts - 6501 Detroit Ave

Local donuts made from spent brewery grains. Amazing selections of classic flavors and new combinations like Maple Bacon, Cap'N Crunch, Mint Oreo, and Peanut Butter Blossom.

#### Brunch / / Astoria - 5417 Detroit Ave

Astoria is a cafe, a bar, a market, and a deli with high-quality imported and domestic food with a Mediterranean twist. Great food and atmosphere.

#### Fried Chicken / / SOHO CHicken & Whiskey - 1889 W 25th St

Perfect fried chicken with homemade hot sauce along with plenty of whiskey options. The hot biscuits are worth the trip alone.

#### Burger / / Local West - 7402 Detroit Ave

Urban, counter-service bistro with creative burgers, many craft beers & outdoor seating.

#### Pizza / / IL RIONE PIZZA - 1303 W 65th St

New York style pizza hidden in Cleveland's former west side Little Italy. This spot has it all: incredible food, good drinks, and high walkability to other neighborhood bars.

# Places to See, Things to Do

### Summer Vibes / / Edgewater Beach - 10 Minute Walk

Sandy beach has a great walking path and picture-perfect view of downtown skyline. Live music and food trucks on Thursday nights in the summer.

#### Nature in the City / / Botanical Gardens

Indoor and Outdoor gardens perfect for families. The Glass House is an amazing structure with over 350 species of exotic plants and 50 free-roaming butterflies, birds, and reptiles. It's a wonderful display of how all these living beings interact with each other in a natural setting.

### Modern Art / / Museum of Contemporary Art - 11400 Euclid Ave

MOCA features exhibits by national and international artists as well as local artists in the Cleveland area. The museum's new building, which opened in 2012, is a unique and impressive structure designed by Farshid Moussavi.

#### Rollercoasters / / Cedar Point Theme Park - www.cedarpoint.com

An hours drive from Cleveland, Cedar Point is home to 71 rides, 18 roller coasters, the Cedar Point Shores Waterpark, and lots of other attractions.
